

Matchday Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The competition is open to all supporters who attend the Manchester City Women v Manchester United Women FA WSL match at the Etihad Stadium (the “**Match**”) on Sunday 11 December 2022, except employees of the Promoter, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the competition. If you are under 18 years of age you must have parental or legal guardian consent before participating in the competition. The Promoter reserves the right to request that you provide contact details of a parent/legal guardian as part of the submission process and may contact your parent or legal guardian to verify such prior permission. If any winner is under the age of 18, we may require these terms and conditions to be signed by the winner’s parent or legal guardian before the prize is awarded. Any such prize may at our discretion be awarded to the winner’s parent/legal guardian. Where a prize involves travel of any description, any winner under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
2. The competition is free to enter for all those who attend the Match and no additional purchase is necessary.
3. To enter the competition, participants must enter the quiz that will take place in the stadium bowl at half time of the Match by scanning the QR code or entering the URL link on the stadium big screens and answering four quiz questions. Only one entry per supporter is permitted
4. The window for entries will begin at half time of the Match, which will be at approximately 1.15pm, on Sunday 11 December 2022. The window for entries will close at the start of the second half of the Match, which will be at approximately 1.30pm, on Sunday 11 December 2022. Entries received after this time will not be accepted.
5. Each supporter who answers each of the four quiz questions correctly will be eligible to win a prize, with the three supporters who answer the questions the most quickly each being crowned a winner. 1st place will be awarded to the supporter who answers correctly most quickly, with 2nd place awarded to the second quickest and 3rd place awarded to the third quickest. Each winner will be identified by a computer process carried out following the conclusion of the competition.

Each winner will receive a prize selected by the Promoter. 1st place will receive a 5 day all-inclusive stay at the Hotel Estival Eldorado in Tarragona, Spain (subject to the terms and conditions of the holiday provider), along with four tickets to the Port Aventura Theme Park (subject to the terms and conditions of the theme park), and £800 spending money. 2nd place will receive a shirt signed by an MCWFC player (subject to player availability, which means that the signature of a specific player cannot be guaranteed). 3rd place will receive four general admission tickets for a future MCWFC game during the 2022/23 season.
7. Each winner will be notified by email or telephone (using the details provided at entry) before Monday 19 December 2022. If a winner does not respond to the Promoter within 14 days of being notified by the Promoter, then the winner’s prize will be forfeited.
